
Phase Two: Set One

Print, cut, laminate and re-use.


How to play the game:

Hide the cards in and around your outdoor area. Place rocks on them to secure them or peg them up in your outdoor space. Then place hoops in a central area where children sort the words into once they have found them. Using chalk, write the letters you are focusing on in the middle of the hoops. If you have no concrete to do this, write them on an old card and secure them with stones. The game aims to race around finding words, reading them and putting them in the hoop with the words initial sound. Once they have completed this, ask the children to help you hide the cards and play again! Can they think of any other ways to play this game while practicing our reading skills?




